# CHILI COOK-OFF RULES

1. Entries must file an Entry Form along with a \$5 entry fee to the Dunn County Historical Society Frost Fair Chili Cook-Off to reserve a spot.
2. The cook-off site will be open at 10 a.m. for registration and set up. Competition begins at 11 a.m. and continues until 1:30 p.m.
  - a. Frost Fair attendees will pay \$5 to taste and judge all the chili entries.
  - b. All proceeds from this event benefit the Dunn County Historical Society.
3. Victors will be honored immediately after votes are counted.
4. Teams will be assigned a 6-foot table.
5. Each entrant is responsible for making two crock pots or one roaster full of chili for the cook-off. Entrants will provide their own cooking utensils. DCHS will provide bowls, napkins, chairs, extension cords and electricity (*the cook-off will be indoors*).
6. Sanitation stations will be provided.
7. Each entrant should supply and display an ingredient list for their chili recipe to alert tasters for allergen purposes.
8. Entrants can decorate their tables in any way they would like.
9. Each entrant will donate its chili to the cook-off competition for consumption and sale that day. Each team is expected to begin serving their chili to the public at 11 a.m.
10. **Any style chili is welcome** — whatever you want to make for the contest is good for us.
